Kathryn Suzanne “Susie” Isner Keffer, 66, of 1319 Summers St., Hinton, died Sunday, Dec. 15, 2002, in Summers Continuous Care Center following a long battle with cancer.

Born June 16, 1936, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Weldon Wesley and Gladys Parker Boone.

Mrs. Keffer was a retired school teacher with the Summers County Board of Education, with 32 years of service.
