RICHMOND, Va. — Emma Dunlap Wise, 93, formerly of 101 Ballengee St., Hinton, died Wednesday, Sept. 24, 2003, in Richmond.

Born Aug. 4, 1910, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Robert Finley and Emma May Wysor Dunlap.

Mrs. Wise attended Hinton elementary schools and graduated from Hinton High School. After one year attendance at Dana Hall in Wellesley, Mass., a preparatory school for college, she continued her education at Randolph Macon Woman's College in Lynchburg, Va. She received her A.B. degree with a major in mathematics and a minor in music and psychology. She was elected to Phi Beta Kappa and was a member of Tri Delta Sorority. She taught mathematics at Hinton High School for 31 years before retiring in 1967 and also served as Dean of Girls at Hinton High School.

She was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Hinton and served as its organist for over 25 years. Among the educational and social organizations to which she belonged are Delta Kappa Gamma, Retired School Employees, Wednesday Club of Hinton, Delphi Club, Hinton Chamber of Commerce, the Friends of the Summers County Library, the Bridge-A-Bit Club, and she was a charter member of the Service Club of Hinton.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Jesse C. Wise; and a sister, May Dunlap Sel-domridge.

Survivors include a daughter, Emma "Gheedie" Wise of Richmond; and several nieces and nephews.

Memorial service will be 1 p.m. Saturday at Pivont Funeral Home Chapel, Hinton, with the Rev. Robert Glaser officiating. Burial will follow in Restwood Memorial Gardens, Hinton.

The family will receive friends noon until time of service Saturday at the funeral home.
