Funeral services for Mrs. Garnet C. Pollock, 23 years old, wife of Charles E. "Ned" Pollock, who died Friday morning in a Charleston hospital following an operation, will be held at the Central Baptist church here, Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock with Rev. H. P. Hackney officiating, assisted by Rev. A. H. Clarke. Burial will follow at the Hill Top cemetery.

Mrs. Pollock was widely known in Hinton and formerly resided here with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. A. D. Lilly. She has a wide circle of friends here who were shocked to hear of her unexpected death. She was a sister of Mrs. Ira E. Briers and Miss Fern Lilly.
