Robert Martin Fitzpatrick, 70 of 515 2nd Ave. Hinton died at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday August 6, 2008 in Summers County A.R.H. in Hinton after a courageous fight against a long illness.

Born September 22, 1937 at Brooks, WV he was the son of the late Martin Michael & Ida Mae Meadows Fitzpatrick.

Bob was a veteran of the United States Air Force, and a former conductor for the C&O Railway Company in Hinton, retiring with 30 years of service. In his earlier years, he had worked for the West Virginia Department of Highways, and was an agent for the Prudential Insurance Agency. In the early seventies, he also owned Bellepoint Esso in Bellepoint, and was a volunteer firefighter for a number of years. He had been a past member of the Jaycee's men's organization during a time when they were responsible for many civic projects, including the creation of the Summers County Hospital.
