Julian M. “Buzzy” Richmond, age 62, of 616 Greenbrier Avenue, Hinton, went home to be with the Lord Thursday, June 27, 2013 at Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown.

Born November 16, 1950 in Hinton, he was the son of the late Julian Q. and Mary Evelyn Thomas Richmond.

Buzzy was a 1968 graduate of Hinton High School, and a 1972 graduate of Concord College. He was a retired school teacher for the Summers County Board of Education with 34 years of service. He was a former basketball coach at Sandstone Junior High School, and coached basketball, track, and football at Hinton High School. He finished his coaching career as the last head football coach at Hinton High School and the first head football coach at Summers County High School. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Hinton.

Buzzy, as he was known by family and friends, was known for his zest for life and his great sense of humor. He was a wonderful husband, father, grandfather, and brother.

He was preceded in death by an infant brother, James David Richmond.

He is survived by his loving wife of almost 40 years, Nancy Harvey Richmond.
