Also known professionally as Angelyn Orr (sometimes spelled as Angeline), her previous married name. Angie played many roles as a career radio actress in Chicago when she was young. She was heard over ever Chicago radio station and every major net-work in such dramatic productions as ,”Grand Hotel”, “First Nighter”, “Backstage Wife”, “Today’s Children”, and “Road of Life”. Angie was Sgt. Betty Jane McDermott in the 1946 film Blondie’s Lucky Day based on the Blondie and Dagwood comic.

Angeline was laid to rest in East Lawn Palms Cemetery and Mortuary in Tucson, AZ.
