### Dempsey B. Fox Succumbs At 42

HINTON (RNS) — Dempsey B. Fox, 42, of Hinton died at 6 a.m. Tuesday at his home after an illness of six months.

Born Jan. 29, 1920, near Sandstone, he was a son of E. B. and Norma Gwinn Fox of Hinton.

He lived all his life in Summers County and in Hinton for 33 years.

An employe of Wilson and Company in Hinton 22 years, he was a member of the Central Baptist Church. He graduated from Hinton High School with the class of 1937 also from Mountain State Business College in Parkersburg.

Other survivors include his wife, Norma; and two sisters, Mrs. William Miller of Huntington and Miss Mary Elsie Fox of Washington, D. C.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday in Central Baptist Church with the Rev. W. Robert McCoy and Dr. H. P. Hackney in charge. Burial will be in the Restwood Memorial Estates.
