

Phyllis Jean Meadows

June 9, 1940 – March 16, 1969

Miss Phyllis Jean Meadows, 28, of Rt. 3 Princeton, died Monday following a long illness at the home of her aunt and uncle, Mr. and Mrs. Henry W. Hill, where she had made her home for most of her life.

She was a member of the New Zion Baptist Church and the young people's BYF group. She was born in Tazewell, Va., the daughter of the late Herbert Meadows, who died in 1947.

Survivors include her mother, Gladys Henkens of Roanoke, Va. and two brothers, Kenneth and Jesse Meadows, both of Bridgeport, Conn.

Funeral services will be conducted at New Zion Baptist Church at 2 p.m. Wednesday with Revs. Donald L. Barns and Fred Kinser officiating. Burial will follow in the New Zion Cemetery.

Cousins will serve as pallbearers and girls of the BYF and Sunday School class girls will be flower bearers.
