Lalon May Tyree Ellison, 90, of Nimitz, died Tuesday, May 6, 1997, in a Hinton care unit following a long illness.

Born Jan. 2, 1907, at Richmond Bottom in Raleigh County, she was the daughter of the late Marshall and Lura Cook Richmond.

Mrs. Ellison was a lifelong resident of Summers County and a member of the First Christian Church of Hinton. She received her teaching certificate from Concord Normal School (Concord College) in 1926, and taught in Summers and Raleigh counties for 16 years.
