Miss Pearlie Thompson, 73, died Sunday, May 31, at home of natural causes.

Born November 7, 1913, at Pipestem, she was the daughter of the late C. J. and Ethel Dickson Thompson.

Miss Thompson was a lifelong resident of Summers County, a member of the Miller Memorial United Methodist Church at Bellepoint and was a former employee of the Summers County Sheriff's Department and the Hinton Maytag Store.

Survivors include a brother, Cyrus Thompson of Beckley; one niece and three nephews.

Services were held Thursday June 4 at 11 a.m. at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlor's Chapel in Hinton with Dr. Clyde Hensley officiating. Burial followed in the Thompson family cemetery at Pipestem.

Survivors include a son, Robert S. Wait of Richmond, Va.; five grandchildren, Sarah Sharpe Mabry of Harrison, Oh., George Sharpe III, of Detroit, Mich., Courtney, Todd and Linda Wait, all of Richmond, Va., and two great-grandchildren.

Services were held Mon. Dec. 3 at 11 a.m. at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlor Chapel with the Revs. Robert Glaser and Stuart McMurray officiating. Burial followed in the Greenbrier Burial Park at Hinton.
