Leo E. Arthur, Jr., 47, of Madams Creek, died Friday December 6 at home apparently of a heart attack.

Born Dec. 2, 1938, at Covington, Va., he was a son of Lillie Peggy Jenkins Arthur of Hinton, and the late Leo Arthur Sr.

Mr. Arthur had lived most of his life in Summers County, was a graduate of Hinton High School, was a locomotive engineer for the Chessle System, was chief of the Summers County Volunteer Fire Department and Rescue Squad and a member of the Hinton United Methodist Church. He was a member of the Hinton National Guard.
