William Taylor Richmond, 70, formerly of Hinton, died Wednesday May 28 in a Beckley hospital after a long illness.

Born June 12, 1915, in Hinton, he was a son of the late Taylor and Mary Alice Farley Richmond.

Mr. Richmond had lived most of his life at Glen Jean, was a 1936 graduate of Hinton High School, was a World War II veteran and was a retired freight agent for the Chessie System.

Survivors include his wife, Ann Richmond; a daughter, Jean Ervin of Charleston, and a grandchild.

Services were held Saturday May 31 at 2 p.m. at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors chapel in Hinton, with Dr. Al Cone officiating. Burial followed in the McKinley Richmond Cemetery near Hinton.
