Eunis Carl Cales, Jr. 57, of 157 Pleasant St., Hinton, was dead on arrival Saturday at 4 p.m. in a Summers County hospital of a heart attack.

Born Oct. 9, 1923, at Pluto, he was a son of Mrs. Pat Murphy Richmond Cales of Hinton and the late E.C. Cales Sr.

Mr. Cales was an engineer for the Chessie System, a veteran of World War II, a member of the Hinton United Methodist Church, Hinton Masonic Lodge, and a member of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers.

Other survivors include his wife, Garnet Jean Farley Cales; one son, Scott Cales of Beckley; one daughter, Regina Cales of Hinton, two brothers, Melvin of Tulsa, Okla., and George of Beckley and three grandchildren.
