Dr. D. O. Nichols Of Charlottesville Succumbs at 57

CHARLOTTESVILLE July 24—Dr. Dan O. Nichols, 57, a general practitioner here for 26 years, died Thursday at a local hospital.

He was born in Hinton, W. Va., and was a graduate of the University of Virginia, where he received his MD in 1926. He interned at Blue Ridge Sanatorium and at the University hospital and practiced in West Virginia for three years before returning to Charlottesville.

He was a member of the Kiwanis Club, Elks' Lodge No. 389, Widows' Sons' Lodge No. 60, AF&AM, Farmington Country Club, Theta Chi Fraternity and the General Practitioners' Society of Virginia. He was also a member of the Albemarle County Medical Society and of the American Medical Association.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Grace Wingfield Nichols; two daughters, Mrs. Thomas M. Whitten and Miss Brenda Nichols, both of Charlottesville, and a grandchild.

Funeral arrangements were incomplete Thursday night.
