Victim of Pneumonia

George Houston Harwood died at his home here Sunday morning Dec. 29, 1935, at 6:20 o'clock. He had been seriously ill of pneumonia, the cause of his death, since December 16th.

Mr. Harwood, who would have been 25 years of age on Jan. 1, 1936, was a graduate of the class of 1933 of the Hinton High School. He was popular among his friends, and while in High school was a member of the football team, playing during three years of varsity competition at the position of end and in the backfield. Much sincere regret is expressed on account of his death and separation from his loved ones.

Mr. Harwood leaves a young wife and child, Jackqueline Marie, aged five months; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. G. H. Harwood, two sisters, Mrs. Weldon Butler and Miss Ruth Harwood, and one brother, Richard, all of Hinton.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon, at 2 o'clock, at the Central Baptist church with Rev. H. P. Hackney, pastor, officiating. Burial followed in the Greenbrier Burial Park.
