Bill George Reid, 53, of 104 Garden St., Hinton, died Friday at 8:30 p.m. in a Hinton Hospital following a cerebral hemorrhage, suffered Thursday morning at home.

Born April 5, 1925, in Hinton, he was a son of L. Merritt and Nora Richmond Reid of Hinton's southside.

He had lived in Hinton all his life and was a sales representative, a member of Miller Memorial United Methodist Church in Bellepoint, and a Navy veteran of World War II, serving in the South Pacific.

Mr. Reid received his Bachelor of Science degree from Concord College and was president of the Concord College He-man's Association. He was a member of the Hinton Benevolent and Protective Order of Elk, the Loyal Order of the Moose and Veterans of Foreign War Post 4500 at Hinton.

Other survivors include his wife, Mary Lou Barbery Reid; three daughters, Robine Kee, Jane Leigh, and Riley Sue, all at home; and one sister, Mrs. Harry (Evelyn) Garrett of Bellepoint.

Funeral services were held Monday at 1 p.m. in the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors with the Rev. Hubert Groves and Bruce Richmond officiating. Burial followed in Restwood Memorial Gardens.
