William F. Lindsay, 71, formerly of Hinton, died Friday February 18 at 8:30 p.m. in a Ronceverte nursing home after a long illness.

Born Nov. 6, 1911, at Hinton, he was a son of the late Henry and Laura Ellis Lindsay.
