Ethel Davis Seymour Dies in Washington

Miss Ethel Davis Seymour, widely and favorably known in Hinton died of pneumonia at 6:15 o'clock Saturday evening in a Washington, D. C. hospital.

A former resident of Hinton, Miss Seymour held positions here with the Hinton Cooperative Mercantile Co. and as business manager of the local Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone company office until five years ago, when she accepted a position as cost manager of the Patrick Henry hotel in Roanoke, Va. She later held the same position with the Statler hotel in Washington. She was a member of the Episcopal church here.

She is survived by one sister, Mrs. J. W. Durham, of Hinton and one brother, E. T. Seymour, of Washington, D. C.

The body was returned to Hinton by the E. M. Meadows funeral home and taken to the home of a sister, Mrs. J. W. Durham, at 312 Seventh avenue.

Funeral services will be conducted at the Durham residence at 2:30 o'clock Tuesday afternoon by the Rev. E. W. Billings, and burial will be made at Hilltop cemetery.
