FORMER RESIDENT DIES SATURDAY IN MONTGOMERY HOSP.

Funeral rites were conducted today at 2 p.m. at the Calfee Funeral Home Chapel in Beckley for Miss Anna Marie Peck, well known Hinton native, who died in the Peck Clinic at Montgomery Saturday after a long illness.

Dr. J. W. Witherspoon officiated at the service with burial following in the Sunset Memorial Park.

Miss Peck, a sister-in-law of Mrs. L. M. Peck and niece of Mrs. W. H. Roberts of this city, was born in Hinton, December 18, 1905, a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Harry D. Peck.

She attended Hinton schools and Marshall College.

She had been hospitalized since April 1, and at the time of her illness was employed as office secretary for the Raleigh County Tuberculosis and Health Association.

Prior to that Miss Peck was employed for 18 years with the Beckley Newspaper Corp. after which she worked for Dr. Harold Harvey.

Other survivors include two brothers, Dr. C. M. Peck and Oliver Lemon Peck both of Beckley.

Serving as pallbearers were Robert F. Cornett, C. O. Boitnoitt, Homer Farley, Fred Roschi, William F. Patton and John F. Flannagan. Honorary pallbearers were members of the Raleigh County Tuberculosis and Health Association.
