Robert Eugene Vass, 64, died Tuesday January 21 in an Alexandria, Va., hospital of natural causes.

Born June 7, 1921, at Hinton, he was a son of the late Robert Lee and Effie Allen Vass.

Mr. Vass was a postmaster at Banco, was a member of the First Baptist Church in Hinton and the National League of Postmasters.

He was a World War II veteran serving in Rome. He was also a recipient of the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star Medal.

Survivors include his wife, Audrey Ward Vass; two daughters, Debora Vass of Annapolis, Md., and Holly Vass of Bethesda, Md.; a son, Robert E.
