Clinton R. Steers dies in hospital

Clinton Ray Steers, 23, of Hinton died at 12:10 a. m. today in Hinton Hospital after entering the hospital at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday. Death was attributed to a cerebral hemorrhage.

Born May 22, 1945, he was a son of Frank W. and Lúia Adkins Steers of Hinton and had lived his entire life here.

Mr. Steers has been employed by Hercules Co. at Covington, Va., for the past five months. He was a graduate of Hinton High School with the class of 1966 and attended Community Christian Church.

Survivors in addition to his parents include a brother, Frederick F. Steers of Hinton, and three sisters, Mrs. Franklin (Virginia) Ward of Sandstone, Mrs. Harry (Elizabeth) Lambert of Hinton, and Mrs. Jay (Ann) Taylor of Hinton.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Friday at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors by the Rev. Fred Miller and Dr. J. F. Atkins. Burial will be in Hilltop Cemetery.

The body will remain at the funeral parlors where friends may call after 7 p.m. today.
