Demolition is expected to commence on the building after January 1.

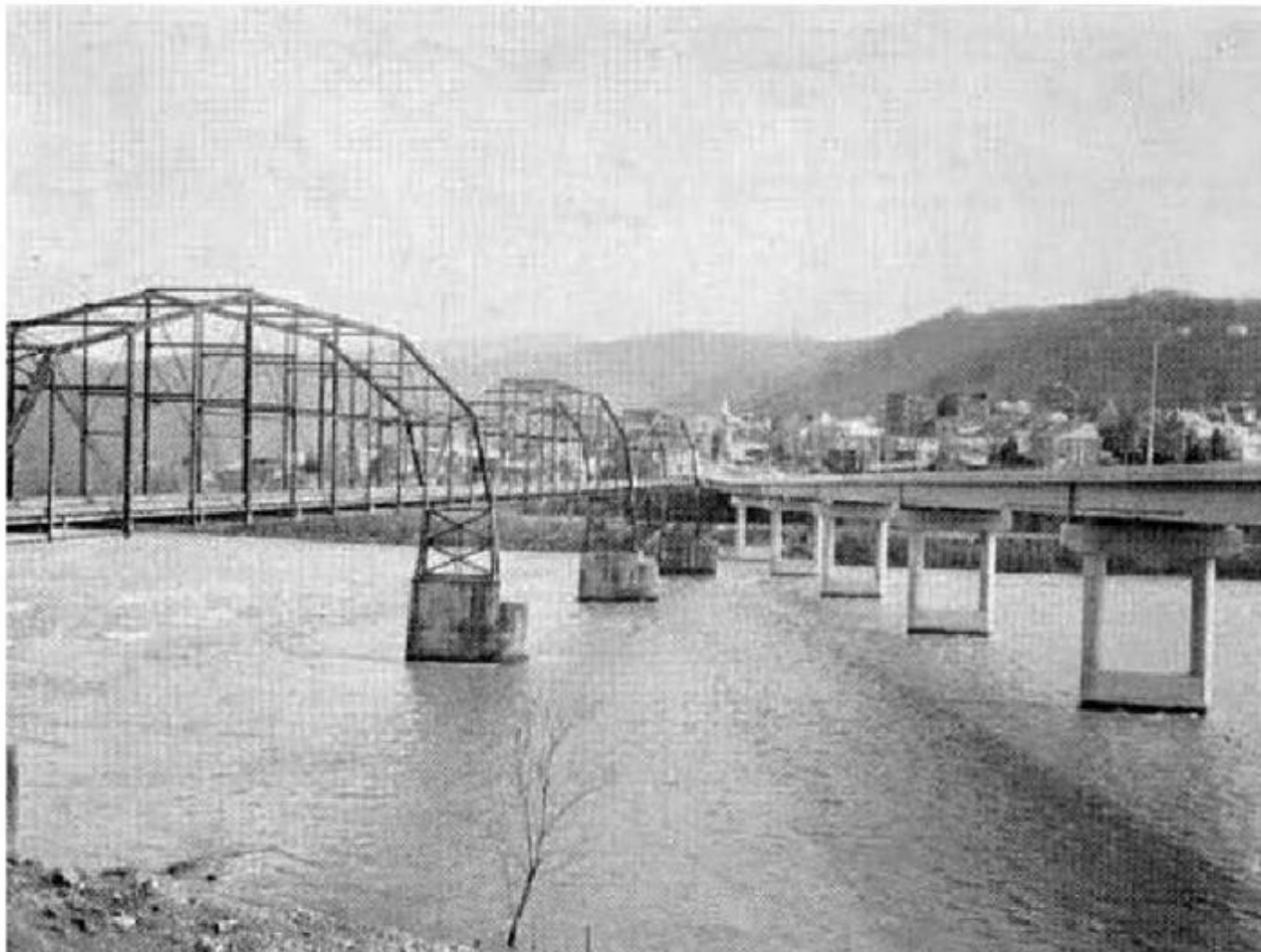

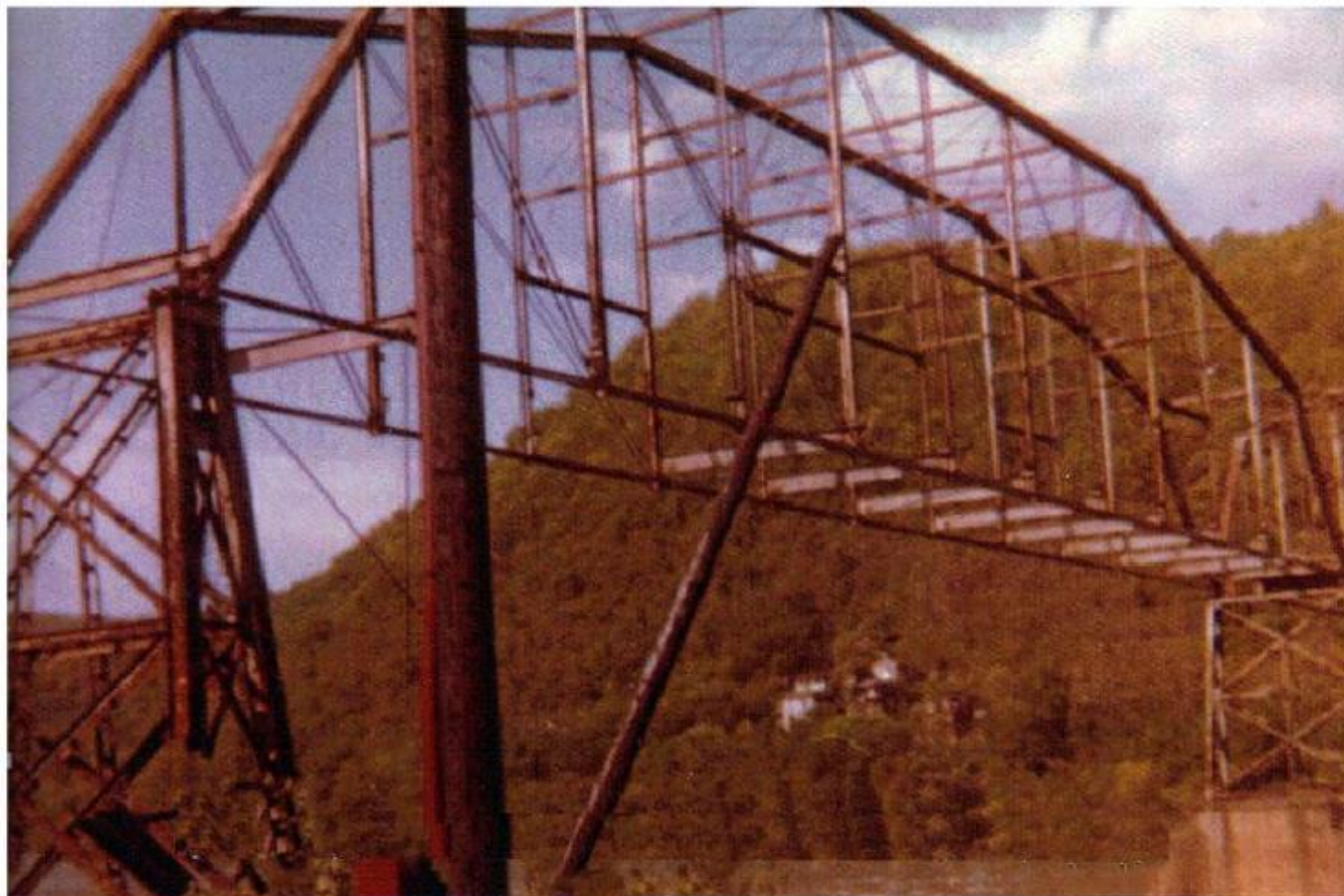


**New River Bridge - Temple Street - Hinton

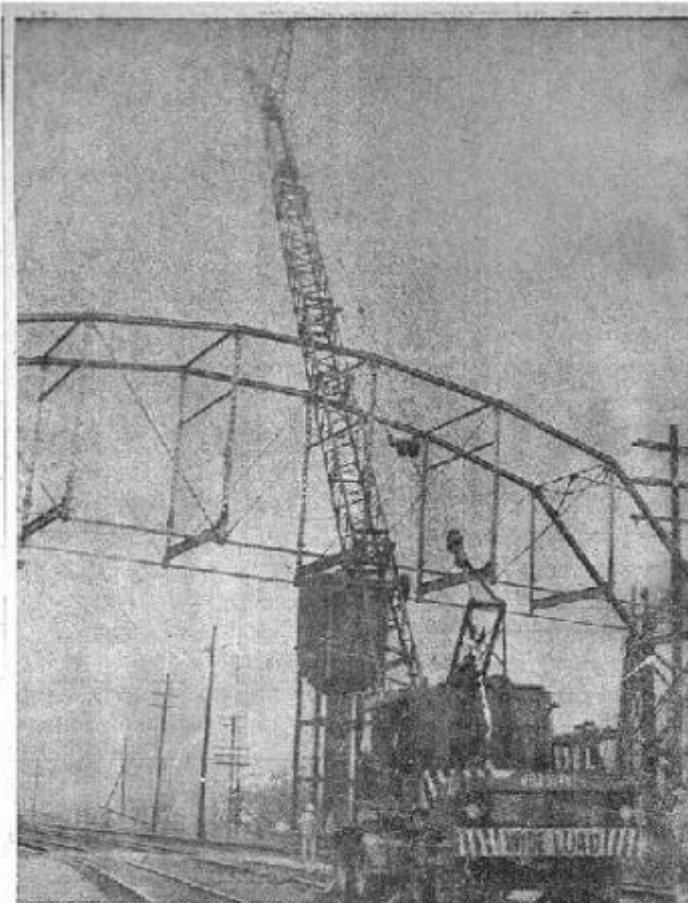

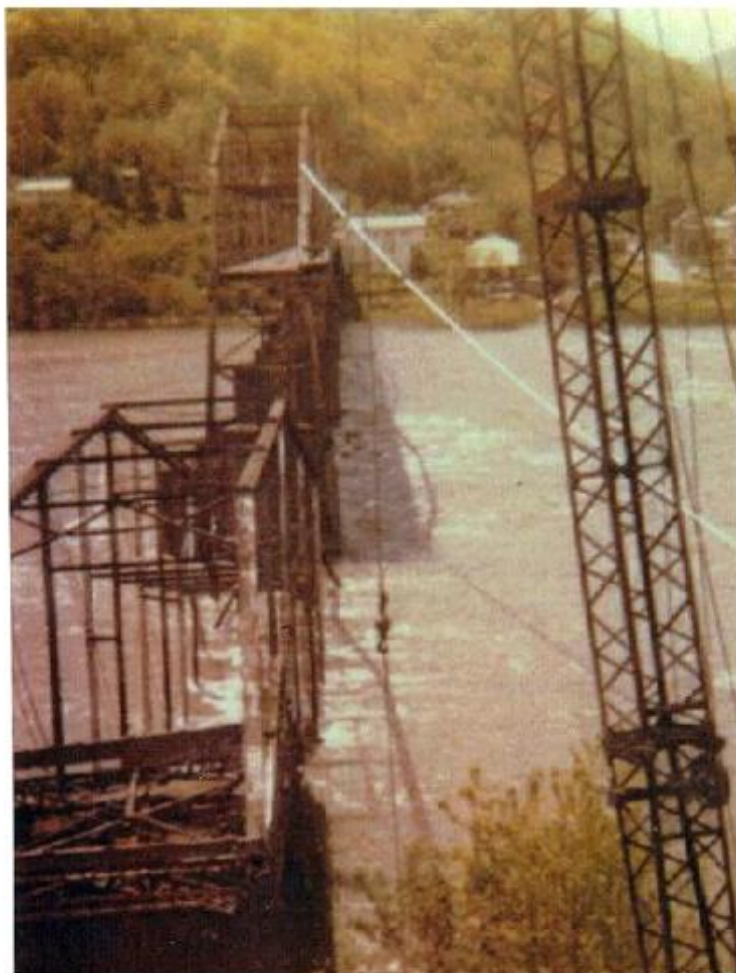

HUGE CRANE BEGINS DISMANTLING BRIDGE — A 120-foot crane began today dismantling the steel superstructure of the old New River bridge. A large group of crane operators watched as the operation began. The first two spans are scheduled to

be pulled down pole this afternoon. The demolition will be completed by late June and bids for a new bridge are supposed to be let in late summer. The work is being done by Melburn Brothers Construction Company of North Canton, Ohio.

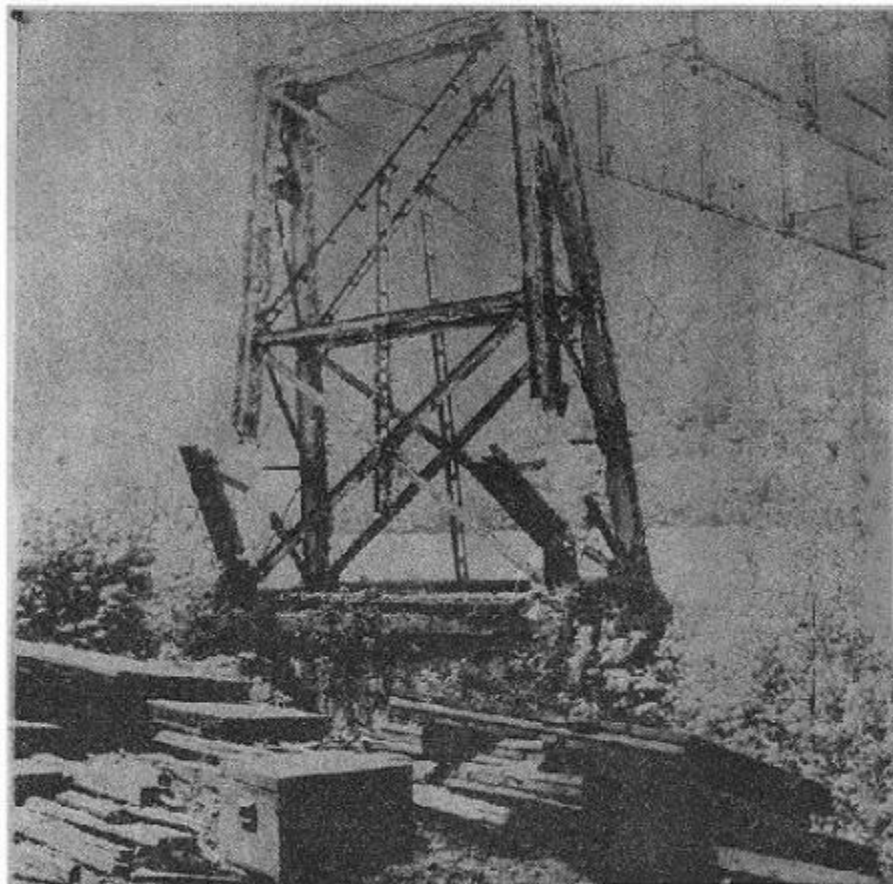

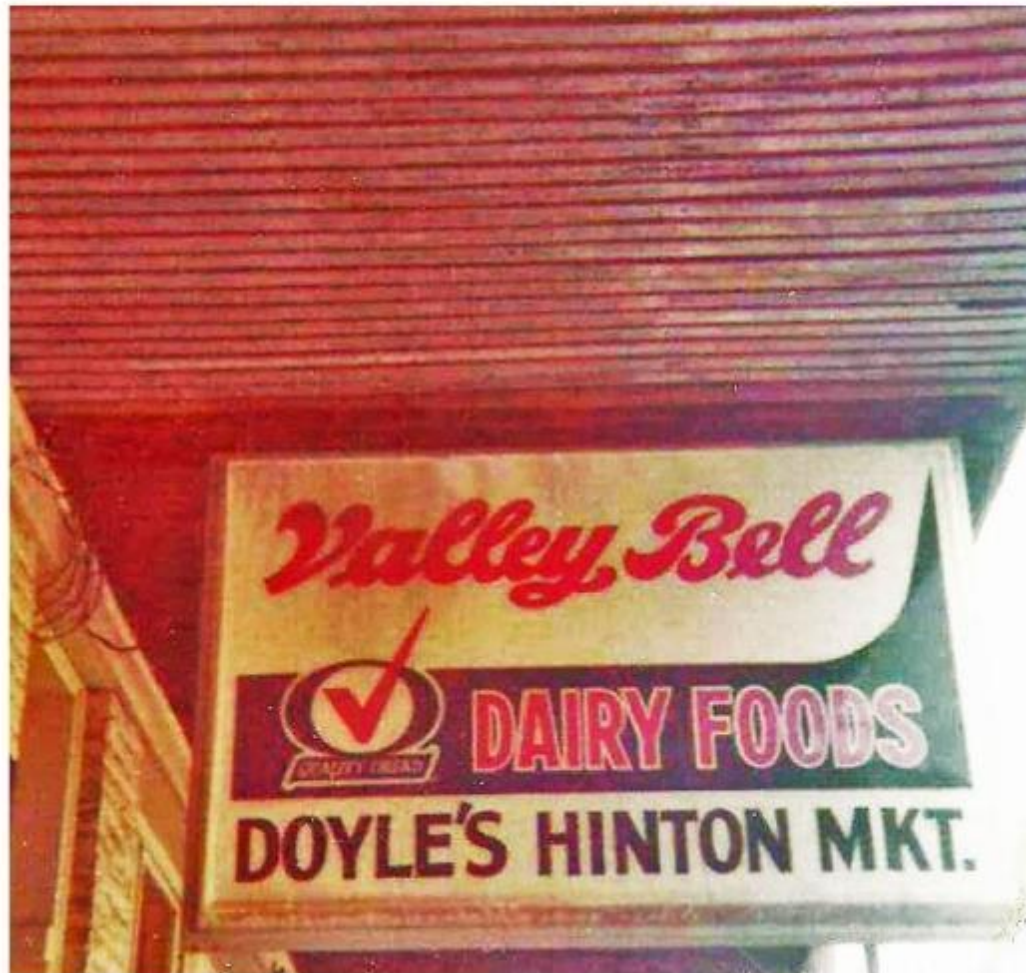

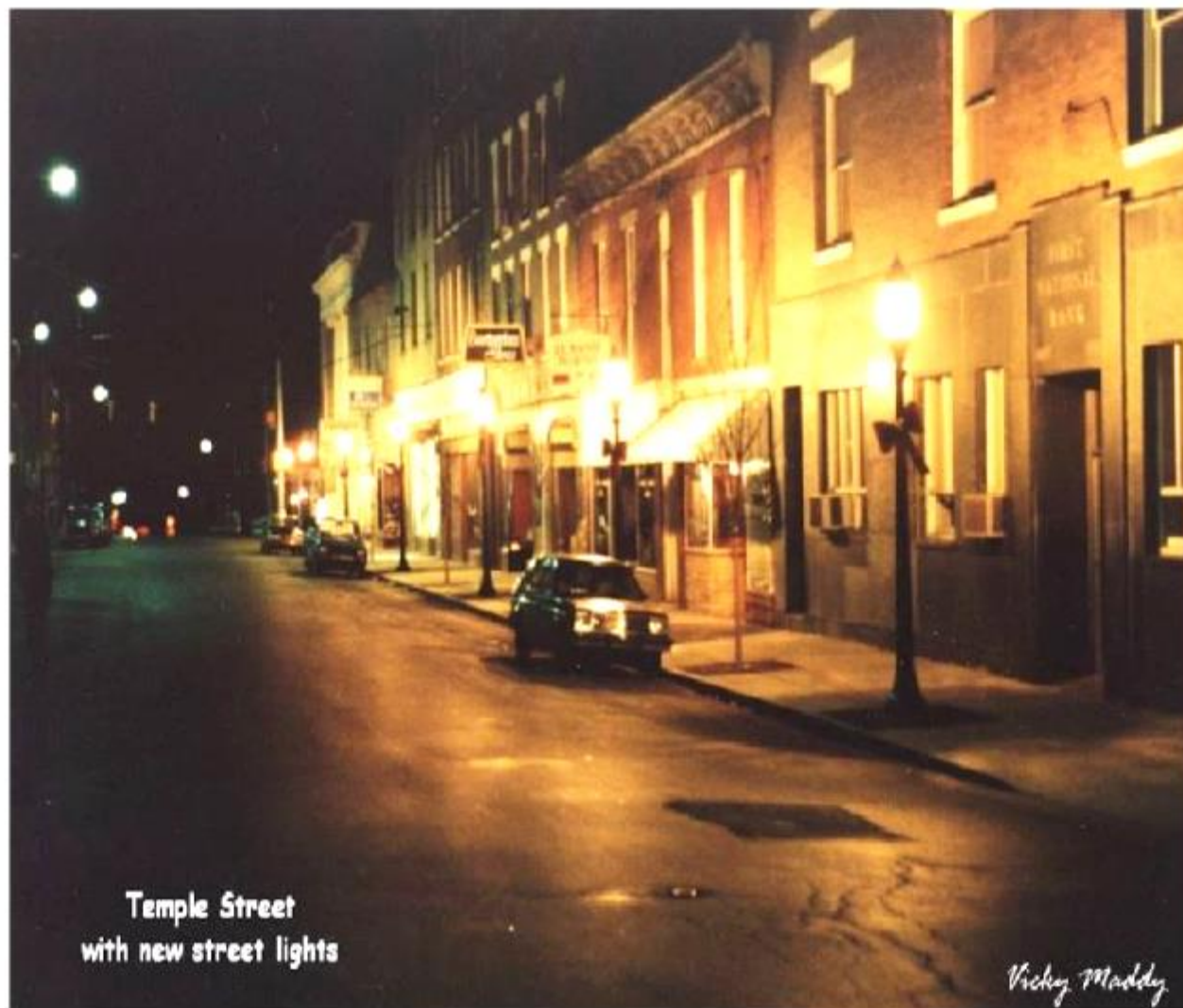
