Andrew Coleman Hank, 96, of 306 16th Ave., Hinton, died 11:19 a. m. Saturday, Sept. 22, 2001, at his home following a long illness.

Born Oct. 30, 1904, at Dietz, he was the son of the late

Mr. Hank was a retired clerk for the C&O Railway Company in Hinton with 46 years service.
