DR. MOORFIELD FUNERAL RITES WILL BE HELD

Although funeral arrangements have not been completed it is believed that services will be conducted in Beckley Wednesday afternoon for Dr. Terrance Clyde Moorefield, 59, widely known Beckley dentist and a former Hinton resident, who died unexpectedly at his office on Main street at 7:30 o'clock Sunday morning. Burial will be made in the Greenbrier Burial Park here.

Dr. Moorefield had practiced dentistry in Beckley for the last 37 years.

He was born at Hinton, May 24, 1897, the son of the late Billy Lee and Lilly Faulconer Moorefield. On Aug. 25, 1917, he married Judith Shepherd.

Dr. Moorefield was a graduate of the Ohio College of Dental Surgery, Cincinnati, Ohio.

He was active in the American Legion, having been past commander of Post 32 two times, past vice-commander of the Department of West Virginia American Legion, and a member of the 40 and 8.

A World War I veteran, Dr. Moorefield was a member of the Beckley First Christian Church and the New River Dental Society.

Survivors in addition to his wife are one son, Jimmie Lee Moorefield of Worcester, Mass.; one sister, Mrs. Kitty Durant of Hollywood, Fla.; one brother, William Moorefield, of Indian Springs, Tenn.; and two grandchildren.
