

Thomas Miller Doyle

April 5, 1941 – May 21, 1972

HINTON – Thomas Miller Doyle, 31, of Hopewell, Va., formerly of Hinton, died Sunday morning en route to a Bluefield hospital. Death was attributed to injuries received in a car accident Friday night on Route 20, west of Hinton.

Born in Summers County, April 5, 1941, he was a son of John and Clara Miller Doyle of Hinton.

He had lived in Hopewell for six years where he was employed by Firestone Synthetic Fibers Co.

He was a member of the Brooklyn Methodist Church on Madams Creek.

Doyle was graduated from Hinton High School in 1959.

Other survivors include his wife, Jo Ann Lilly Doyle of Hopewell; two brothers, David of North Augusta, S.C., and Mickey of Hinton; the maternal grandmother, Mrs. Jenny Miller of Greenville, and the paternal grandmother, Mrs. Blanche Doyle of Hinton.

The Funeral will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Brooklyn Methodist Church with Rev. G.M. Ford and Rev. J.O. Hambrick in charge. Burial will be in the family cemetery at Ellison.

The body will remain at Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors where friends may call after 3 p.m. today and will be taken to the church one hour prior to the funeral.
