Hazel attended Hinton High School and graduated from Covington High School in Covington, Virginia in 1941. She graduated from Concord College with a BS in Education in 1946 and received a Master's Degree from West Virginia University in 1948. Her career included 34 years of teaching with the Summers County Schools as well as several summers at Concord College Teacher Training School and with the Summers County Head Start Program.
