Walter Earl Lilly, 81, died Thursday, June 11, at 1:05 p.m. at a Beckley hospital following a long illness.

Born February 4, 1906, at Jumping Branch, he was the son of the late Henry Preston and Nancy Elizabeth Mann Lilly.

Mr. Lilly was a lifelong resident of Jumping Branch and a member of the Rhoda Ann Memorial Missionary Baptist Church at Streeter. He was a retired shop employee from the C&O Railway and a retired foreman from the West Virginia Department of Highways.

He was preceded in death by a grandson, Richard Earl Stanley in 1974.

Survivors include his wife, Marie Pack Lilly; a son, Sidney Earl Lilly of Forest Hill; two daughters, Mrs. Emory (Wilda) Meredith of Rich Creek, Va., and Mrs. Richard (Nina) Stanley of Daniels; seven

grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
