Services for James H. M. Ewart, a retired senior vice president of the Chemical Bank in New York, will be held at 2.30 P.M. Wednesday in the chapel at Green Mount Cemetery.

A mass of the resurrection for Mr. Ewart, who was 73 and died Saturday at his home in New York, will be offered at 10.45 A.M. tomorrow at St. Thomas More Church there.

A native of Hinton, W. Va., he was a graduate of the Phillips Exeter Academy and, in 1924, of Yale University, where he obtained a law degree in 1927.

He is survived by his wife, the former Eleanor Whelan, whom he married in Baltimore in 1934; two daughters, Mrs. Hamilton Southworth, Jr., of New York, and Mrs. William
