Dorothy Virginia Bailey, 86, of Meadow Lane, Crab Orchard, formerly of Hinton, died Saturday, Dec. 28, 2002, in a Charleston hospital following a short illness.

Born Oct. 2, 1916, at Cass, she was the daughter of the late Earnest F. and Pearl A. Brown Hall.

Mrs. Bailey spent her childhood in Summers County and was a graduate of Hinton High School. She had been a resident of Crab Orchard for over 55 years where she worked at the Crab Orchard Post Office, retiring with 17 1/2 years of faithful service. She was an active member of the Crab Orchard Baptist Church participating in the Byrd Bible Class, Circle No. 4, the church choir and the quilting club. She was also a member of the American Baptist Women of West Virginia and the Talcott Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star.

Her husband, John Burton Bailey, preceded her on Sept. 11, 1988; and she was also preceded by a grandson.

Survivors include four sons, John R. Bailey of Grant, Ala., James F. Bailey of Falmouth, Va., David L. Bailey of Nashville, Tenn. and Robert B. Bailey of Forest Hill; and nine grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

Services will be 10 a.m. Tuesday at Melton Mortuary Chapel with the Rev. Phil Shields officiating. Burial will follow in the Restwood Memorial Park, Hinton.
