LEWISBURG — Henry Franklin Lindsay Jr., 79, was dead on arrival at a Fairlea medical center Saturday, Dec. 31, 1994, following a long illness.

Born March 13, 1915 at Hinton, he was the son of the late Henry F. Lindsay Sr. and Laura Ellis Lindsay.

Mr. Lindsay had been a resident of Lewisburg all of his adult life, was a member of Lewisburg United Methodist Church, a charter member of Maxwelton Ruritan Club, member of Lewisburg Masonic Lodge No. 42 AF and AM and Bene Kedem Shrine, was retired manager of A&P Tea Co. at Lewisburg and a farmer.
