



## **Harry Robert Harris**

Harry Robert Harris died peacefully on Thursday, January 29, 2009 at the Armed Forces Retirement Home in Washington, DC.

Born in Hinton, Summers County, West Virginia, Harry was a son, brother, uncle, father and friend. He was a student, sailor, medical corpsman, warrior, civil servant and patriot. He joined the U.S. Navy in 1938, served in the South Pacific in WWII and retired after 23 years of service. He later retired from the U.S. Postal Service in Los Angeles, CA. In 1993 he relocated to the Soldier's Home in Washington where he lived among other Armed Forces veterans. Harry was known for his shy reclusiveness, but he touched many lives with his gentle kindness and civility.

The last of nine sisters and brothers, Harry lived 91 years, three weeks and two days. He will be an inspiration to his family and friends forever.

There will be no public viewing or other services.
