### **Robert H. Bailey**

Final rites for Robert Holbrook Bailey, 40, Hinton, will be conducted at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Central Baptist Church at Hinton with the Rev. W. R. McCoy and the Rev. Fred Dillon in charge. Burial will be in Restwood Memorial Estates.

Bailey died Sunday at his home. Death was attributed to internal injuries caused by blows to the head.

An employe of the Hinton Post Office Department, Bailey was the husband of Mrs. June R. Bailey, warden of the West Virginia Prison for Women at Pence Springs.

Born in Summers County, Aug. 3, 1926, he was a son of Mrs. Dessie Bailey of Hinton and the late Newton D. Bailey.

He was a veteran of World War II and the Korean War; a member of the Central Baptist Church at Hinton, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and Moose Lodge, and a sergeant in a National Guard unit at Hinton.

Other survivors include a son, Robert Jr., and two daughters, Marie and Suzanna, all at home, and two sisters, Mrs. Madeline Stewart and Mrs. Louise Phillips, both of Beckley.

Members of the National Guard Unit at Hinton will conduct full military rites.

The body will remain at the E. M. Meadows Funeral Home in Hinton. (RNS)
