Howard Franklin Bugg III, 48, of 107 Ballengee St., died Sunday February 3 at 11:45 a.m. in a Summers County hospital apparently of a heart attack.

Born April 21, 1936, in Ansted, he was a son of Edith Bugg Coffman of Hinton and the late Howard F. Bugg Jr.

Mr. Bugg had lived most of his life in Hinton, was an employee of the Department of Interior, Office of Surface Mining in Beckley, a member of the Central Baptist Church and a graduate of Hinton High School and West Virginia University. He was a member and treasurer of the Hinton Moose Lodge and a member and past exalted ruler of the Hinton Elks Lodge.

Other survivors include his wife, Jane Davis Bugg; three sons, Howard F. Bugg IV of McAllen, Texas, Clayton R. Bugg of Alexandria, Va., and Timothy K. Bugg of Hinton; a daughter, Laurie T. Bugg of Hinton;
