REV. FRANK W. MONROE

The Rev. Frank William Monroe, 90, of Florence, S.C., formerly of Hinton, died Tuesday, Sept. 22, 1998, in a Florence medical center following an illness.

Born at Hinton, he was the son of the late William Francis and Maude Alice Houchins Monroe.

The Rev. Monroe was ordained as a Baptist minister in 1943, and for the past 55 years he pastored Baptist churches in West Virginia and South Carolina. He served 21 years as associate pastor of Florence Baptist Temple.

Survivors include his wife, Hallie Greene Monroe; a daughter, Ann Konnerup of Nairobi, Kenya, Africa; three sons, James E. Monroe of Talcott, William T. Monroe of Florence and Paul M. Monroe of Columbia, S.C.; 12 grandchildren; and 12 great-grandchildren.

Services were held at 11 a. m. Thursday, September 24th. at Florence Baptist Temple. Burial followed in Florence Memorial Gardens.
