### **James A. Graham Claimed By Death**

HINTON, May 10 (RNS) — James A. Graham, 35, of Bellefonte, Pa., a former Hinton resident, died unexpected Saturday at his home.

Son of the late James A. Graham, pioneer Summers county resident, he was a graduate of Hinton high school, and attended the engineering school at West Virginia University prior to entering the military service during World War II. He was decorated for heroism in action in both World War II and in the Korean War.

He is survived by his wife; his mother, Mrs. Mae Graham, of Washington, D. C., and the following half-brothers and sisters: Mrs. H. G. Humphries and S. J. Graham, of Hinton; Roscoe Graham, Charleston, and Mrs. Baker Harris, of Philadelphia. He was in Hinton several weeks ago attending the funeral of another half-brother, the late H. O. "Doc" Graham.
