Mrs. Cynthia B. (Cindy) Richmond, 24, and Craig Peterson Richmond, 3, died Wednesday April 25 of injuries received in an automobile accident on Rt. 3 south of Hinton, according to Hinton State Police.

Born Feb. 11, 1960, in Morgantown, she was a daughter of Jesse W. and Arbutus Ward Gill of Willowood Road, Hinton.

Mrs. Richmond was a lifelong resident of Summers County, was an employee of the Summers County Hospital in Hinton, a member of the Women of the Moose and was a 1978 graduate of Hinton High School.

Other survivors include her husband, Gerald L. Richmond; a daughter, Jillian Leigh Richmond at home; three brothers, Jesse Jr. and Timothy Gill, both of Hinton and Douglas Gill of Trenton, Ohio; a sister, Deborah Parker of Trenton, Ohio; paternal grandmother, Bessie Adkins of Lanark.

Craig P. Richmond, born January 9, 1981, in Beckley, he was a son of Glad L. Richmond and the late Cynthia Richmond.
