Robert P. (Bun) Goff, 75, of 409 Miller Ave. died Tuesday at 7:15 p.m. at the home of his nephew, Dr. Rodney Dean of Charleston, after a long illness.

Born March 19, 1905, in Hinton, he was a son of the late William and Nannie Martin Goff.

Mr. Goff, a lifelong resident of Hinton, was a member of the First Baptist Church in Hinton, was graduated from Concord College and West Virginia University.

He retired in 1966 as a Summers County school teacher after 36 years of service, was a former assistant football coach for 12 years, basketball coach for eight years, a member of Hinton Masonic Lodge and a World War II Navy veteran where he obtained the rank of lieutenant commander.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Ata W. Goff, and a sister, Mrs. Nell Goff Davis of Hinton.

Funeral services were held Friday at 2 p.m. in Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors in Hinton with the Rev. Lance Yost officiating. Burial followed in the Greenbrier Burial Park in Hinton.
