Burton R. (Turk) Gunnoe, 55, of Peterstown, died Monday in a Beckley hospital following a long illness.

Born at Frankford, he was a son of the late Henry R. Gunnoe and Mrs. Ada Burton Gunnoe of Hinton. Owner and operator of Gunnoe's Supermarket in Peterstown since 1963, he was a member of the Associated Grocers of Virginia. Formerly, he was a manager in Hinton and Peterstown for C. J. Casdorff and Sons chain stores. He was treasurer of the Peterstown fire department, a member and past master of the John Dove Lodge No. 78 AF&AM at Peterstown, a shiner, a member of the Methodist Church, a veteran of World War II and a veteran of foreign wars.

Survivors in addition to his mother include his widow, Mrs. Virginia Michael Gunnoe; two daughters, Mrs. Lois Ann Hess of Sandusky, Ohio, and Mrs. Virginia Sue Wykle of Richmond, Va.; one brother, Clarence J. Gunnoe of Hinton; and one grandson.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Thursday in Broyles Funeral Chapel, Peterstown, with Rev. Joe Geiger officiating. Burial will follow in Peterstown Cemetery.

Members of the John Dove Lodge will conduct graveside rites and serve as pallbearers.
