Clifford L. Ratliff, Jr., 51, formerly of Hinton, died Tuesday August 9 at home apparently of a heart attack.

Born Nov. 8, 1931, in Summers County, he was a son of Fonda Cooper Ratliff of Hinton and the late Clifford L. Ratliff Sr.

Mr. Ratliff had lived the early part of his life in the Hinton area, was a U.S. Marine Corp veteran of the Korean War. He was a minister and had done evangelist work in the western states for the past several years. He is the former director of the Chapel Rescue Mission in Denver, Col.

Other survivors include a son, Michael Ratliff of Rodman, N.Y.; three daughters, Diane Reed of Adams, N.Y., Pamela Spier of Syracuse, N.Y. and Katrina Maltba of Witchita Falls, N.Y., and Katrina Maltba of Witchia Falls, Tex.; a brother, Tony B. Ratliff of Goose Creek, S.C.; four sisters, June Bailey and April Woodrum, both of Hinton, Anna Mae McDowell of Charlotte, N.C., and Betty Surber of Orlando, Fla.; three grandchildren.

The body was cremated.
