Cuero City Judge Kirk Dies at 54

CUERO—Bert A. Kirk Jr., 54, well-known Cuero attorney and civic leader, died in a Cuero hospital Monday night.

Mr. Kirk, who had been active in numerous civic, charitable and business organizations, came to Cuero during World War II and was stationed at Brayton Field in military intelligence.

He was corporation court judge for the City of Cuero at the time of his death. He formerly served as DeWitt County veterans service officer.

Mr. Kirk was a native of McDonald, West Va., but was raised in Hinton, West Va.

He was married to Ada Koenig of Cuero in 1944.

Rosary will be recited at Freund Funeral Home at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday. Requiem Mass will be said at St. Michael's Catholic Church at 10 a.m. Wednesday. The Rev. Peter Higgins will officiate. Burial will be in Hillside Cemetery.
