Principal Dies; Rites Saturday

QUINNIMONT — Mrs. Paul B. (Mabel) Wauhop, principal of the Quinnimont Elementary School died at her home early Thursday at Prince.

Surviving are her husband and a brother, Alex Bannister, Brenton.

Mrs. Wauhop was a member of the Baptist Church at Quinnimont and is the only charter member of the Ladies Aid Society of the church. She was graduated in 1921 from Hinton High School, attended Alderson Junior College and Marshall College for two years. She received her AB

degree at Concord College.

The deceased was also a member of the Eastern Star Chapter at Lawton.

Born at Sewell, she was a daughter of the late Thomas and Rosa Cross Bannister. She had taught school since 1924.

The funeral will be conducted at 2:30 p.m. Saturday at the Quinnimont Baptist Church by the Rev. Donald Lowe. Burial will be in Blueridge Memorial Gardens.

The body will be taken to the home at 4:30 p.m. today from Webb and Neal Funeral Home at Beckley.

Members of the Eastern Star will conduct graveside rites.
