HINTON — William T. Weber, 80, of 510 Miller Ave., died Wednesday, Nov. 1, 1995, at his home following a long illness.

Born Nov. 2, 1914, at Hinton, he was the son of the late William and Lena Sampson Weber.

Mr. Weber had lived the early part of his life in Hinton, returning to Hinton in 1986. He was a graduate of Hinton High School, Concord College and received his master's degree from Marshall University.

He retired in 1979 from the Fort Lauderdale (Fla.) School System, where he was an instructor, coach and athletic director. He was a member of the Bobcat Boosters Club and was active in all phases of athletics throughout Southern West Virginia.

Mr. Weber was voted West Virginia High School Coach of the Year during his undefeated football season at South Charleston High School in 1945.

He was a member of the Hinton First Presbyterian Church, the Hinton Elks Lodge and was a World War II U.S. Coast Guard veteran.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Edward Weber.

Survivors include his wife of 51 years, Lucille Wicker Weber; and a niece, Patricia Demente of Davis, Calif.

Services will be 11 a.m. Saturday at Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors Chapel, Hinton, with Pastor Robert Glaser officiating. Burial will follow in Greenbrier Burial Park, Hinton.
