Hugh "Kink" Hughes, 68, of 113 Fairlawn Ave., died Saturday in a local hospital after a long illness.

Born Feb. 9, 1911, in Hinton, he was a son of the late H.G. "Bud" Hughes and Elizabeth Bell Hughes.

Mr. Hughes was a member of the First Baptist Church, the Beni Kedem Temple of Charleston, the Scottish Rites Bodies, the Legion of Honor, Beckley Shrine Club, Beckley Masonic Lodge 95 AF & AM, the Elks Club No. 1452 and the Moose Club. He was also a veteran of World War II.
