## MARY ELEANOR MEADOWS

Mary Eleanor Meadows, 94, of 1001 Temple St., Hinton, died at 6:25 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 29, 2009, in Summers County A.R.H. in Hinton following a long illness.

Born Jan. 6, 1915, in Hinton, she was the daughter of the late James Green and Effie Miller Meadows.

Miss Meadows was a graduate of Hinton High School and West Virginia University. While at WVU, she was very active in campus activities, including being selected Sweetheart of Sigma Chi Sorority. She spent her entire career teaching English at Hinton High School beginning in 1937 and retiring in 1973. Through the years at Hinton High, she helped many students in preparing for higher education and career choices. She was a member of the Hinton United Methodist Church, the Hinton Woman's Club, Summers County Retired Teachers Association and the Hinton Senior Citizens. Miss Meadows was a lifelong resident of Hinton.

She was the last surviving member of her family.

Survivors include several cousins, and several close friends.

Funeral services were held at 2:30 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 1, 2009, at Pivont Funeral Home Chapel in Hinton with Rev. Rick Duncan officiating. Burial followed in Greenbrier Burial Park in Hinton.

Friends called from 12 noon until time of services on Sunday, Nov. 1 at the funeral home.
