Carl Douglas “Buster” Lilly, 87, of Prosperity, died at 4:40 a.m. Friday, Jan. 29, 1993, in a Beckley hospital, following a short illness.

Born June 27, 1905, in Hinton, he was the son of the late Thomas W. Lilly and Jaley Whitten Lilly.

Mr. Lilly was a retired employee of Eastern Gas and Fuel Co. in the General Department Store Division, was of the Baptist faith and had been a resident of Prosperity since 1965. He was the last surviving member of his immediate family.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Grace Price Lilly, in September 1979; four brothers and three sisters.

Survivors include a son, W. C. “Bill” Lilly of Prosperity; one grandchild; two great-grandchildren; and two nephews.
