Isaac “Ike” Madison Lambert, 71, of Hinton died Friday, February 11, 2011 at Raleigh General Hospital following a long illness.

Born August 14, 1939 at Pineville he was the son of the late John Kee and Nellie Glea Bailey Lambert.

Ike was a graduate of Hinton High School with the class of 1957, and a veteran of the United States Army where he worked in the Pentagon on the IG Inspection Team.
