

Rosalie Peaco Toler

September 16, 1938 – June 14, 1972

HINTON – Services will be 11 a.m. Saturday at E.M. Meadows Funeral Home, here for Mrs. Rosalie Peaco Toler, one of two persons killed Wednesday in separate car wrecks in the state.

The other fatality was Leonard Lee Hall, 45, of Lenore, Mingo County, who died when the car he was driving went out of control on a secondary road and hit an embankment.

Mrs. Toler, 33 of Belva, Nicholas County, died when the car in which she was a passenger plunged over a bank along W.Va. 3 near Pence Springs. The car was driven by her husband, the Rev. Jim “Tom” Toler.

She was a practical nurse at Greenbrier Manor Nursing Home, Lewisburg, and was a native of Hinton.

Also surviving are a daughter, Margaret at home; a son, Michael at home; parents Raymond and Margaret Price Peaco of Hinton.

The service will be conducted by the Rev. L.A. Garten. Burial will be in the Greenbrier Burial Park here.
