

John R. “Piggy” Pack, Jr.

HINTON – John R. “Piggy” Pack, Jr., age 61, of 150 Bridge St., Hinton, died Wednesday, Dec. 1, 2004, at his home following a long illness.

Born Sept. 20, 1943, at Hinton, he was the son of the late John R. Pack and Cornelia Mann Pack.

Mr. Pack was a retired locomotive engineer of the CSX Transportation Corp. in Hinton. He was a member of the United Transportation Union and a member of the Camon Baptist Church in Hinton. He was a United States Army veteran and a lifelong resident of Hinton.

He was preceded in death by two sisters, Lauren and Christine Pack.

Survivors include four brothers; Kenneth and Harold E. Pack, both of Hinton, Richard Pack of Detroit, Mich. And William Pack of Lewisburg; three sisters, Gloria Ford, Maureen Fullen and Juanita McCray, all of Hinton; a close friend, Cathy Spencer of Hinton; and several nieces and nephews also survive.
