

Newman Faulconer

Dr. C. Newman Faulconer, 94, died May 18, 2003, at National Health Care Center of Mauldin after a period of declining health.

Born in Hinton, W.Va., he was the son of the late Dr. and Mrs. E.N. Faulconer.

He was a graduate of Davis and Elkins College and Union Theological Seminary. He received his Doctor of Divinity in 1949. His pastorates were Presbyterian churches in Buchanan, Norfolk and Waynesboro, Va., as well as First Presbyterian Church of Greenville until his retirement, after which he was Minister Emeritus. Following his retirement in 1973, he served as interim minister for 21 years for numerous Presbyterian churches in the S.C. Upstate.

Dr. Faulconer was predeceased by his wife, Katharine, his sister, Alice, his brother, John, and his grandson Tommy Hawpe. He is survived by his brother, Thomas, of Hinton, W.Va., his daughter and son-in-law, Kitty and Tom Hawpe of Simpsonville; son and daughter-in-law, Mike and Toni Faulconer of Greenville; two granddaughters, Kathy Hawpe Beddingfield of Huntersville, N.C., and Kristen Faulconer Welborn of Duncan, S.C.; and three nieces, two nephews and five great-grandchildren.

He served in various positions with the Presbytery, Synod and the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church, US and on the board of Directors or Trustees for Presbyterian College, Blue Ridge Council of Boy Scouts, American Cancer Society and Goodwill Industries. Additionally, Dr. Faulconer was a musician, photographer, travel guide, author and woodcrafter.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 3 p.m. in Harper Chapel at First Presbyterian Church with Dr. Randolph Kowalski officiating. The family will receive friends from 2 until 3 p.m. in the church parlor.
