Mrs. Mary Catherine Thompson, 77, died Mon. Mar. 11, at 3:45 p.m., at a Hopewell, Va., hospital, following a long illness.

Born Dec. 14, 1913, at Sewell, she was the daughter of the late Hiram Thomas and Minnie Saunders Hatcher.

Mrs. Thompson was a lifelong resident of Hinton, was a former employee of the old Hinton Hospital, was a member of the Upland Baptist Church.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Joe Thompson Sr. in Apr. of 1973 and a son, Joe Thompson Jr., in Apr. of 1990.

Survivors include two sons, Jack and Arthur Thompson, both of Hopewell; two daughters, Fran Hockman of Rapidan, Va., and Geneva Meek of Olney, Md.; a brother, Tom Hatcher of Fort Springs; five sisters, Ruby McGraw of Buck, Martha Taylor of Lockbridge, Birdie Gill of Upland, Cecil Gill of Lewisburg and Nancy Williams of Madams Creek, Hinton; 15 grandchildren, and 13 great-grandchildren.

Services were held Thurs. Mar. 14 at 11 a.m. with Pastors Sonny Angell and Dwight Spade officiating. Burial followed in the Upland Cemetery.

The body was at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors in Hinton and at the church one hour prior to the services.
